

SUMMERSCHOOL in "INTERNATIONAL COMMERCIAL CONTRACTS"

VERONA, 3-6 JUNE 2014

The School of Law of the University of Verona, Italy, in cooperation with the Center for International Legal Education (CILE) of the University of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, USA, invites you to attend the Summer School program in International Commercial Contracts, which will take place on June 3-6, 2014 at the School of law of the University of Verona, Italy. The Summer School aims at providing participants with an in-depth understanding of drafting, managing and litigating international contracts. The course will deal with the different sources of law applicable to international contracts, relevant model contract clauses and selected types of contracts of particular relevance in international practice.

Target group and prerequisites for admission

The School is addressed to legal professionals and other business operators involved in international contract practice, but also open to 2nd-level degree and PhD students. A very good level of English is a fundamental prerequisite for admission.

Instructors will include top-level academics and professionals in the field, such as: Prof. Ronald A. Classes will meet at the School of Law in Verona every day, from Tuesday to Friday, six to eight hours per day, up to a total weekly amount of 30 hours. All classes will be in English.
