CURRENT ACADEMIC POSITION

Associate Professor of Economic Law.

Since 1 March 2007 he is associate professor of Economic Law.

From the 2002-2003 academic year (a.y) to 2007 he lectured at the University of Bolzano, Faculty of Economics - Brunico (Private law); the University of Florence, Faculty of Economics (Economic Law) and the University of Verona, Faculty of Law (Economic Law).

In 2006 he obtained the title of Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D) at the Institute of Advanced Legal Studies, University of London, discussing a thesis on "The EC law of on-line investment services" .

From 2002 to 2005 he was a researcher at the British Institute of Comparative and International Law (BICL) in London.

In 2002 he obtained the title of Master of Philosophy (M.Phil) at the Institute of Advanced Legal Studies, University of London. In July 2001 he was awarded the annual scholarship for the study abroad of the "Cesifin-Alberto Predieri" Foundation.

He graduated in Law on 3 April 2001 with a 110 out of 110 mark and cum laude from the University of Florence with a thesis on private international law and litigation entitled "The law applicable to the branch of a foreign bank", supervisor Prof. Francesco Salerno.
